New Business.

Mark welcomed the two new members Ken and Dan. He explained the purpose of the Commission and the history of the list of historic properties. A few historic properties have been removed for development, but the township is now about 90% built out. Ken mentioned that he lives in Gateway Apartments where there is a historic building. Mark explained how it was moved from next to the intersection to its current location in order to preserve it.

Hershey's Mill Dam – Mark commented that this was an active grist mill. The Corps of Engineers required removal because of possible flooding. The Township breached the dam and is installing a park which will have walking trails, fishing ponds and parking. The old mill house was bought and is being renovated. The work has started on the dam.

Milltown Dam – Mark mentioned that this is a historic dam built in the 1800's. It also had to be breached due to concerns of down stream flooding. Behind the dam there was a huge pond but it was slowly drained and is going back to the original stream. There is going to be a park there too. Work should start in 2022.

ABC Meeting - Mark explained that this meeting is for all of the members of the Authorities, Boards and Commissions of the Township. Its purpose is for the ABC members to meet and hear about what the other ABCs have done and plan to do for the next year. It will be held on Zoom on Tuesday, January 26, 2021 at 6:30 pm.

Dear Property Owner:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Carl and Beth Holden (APPLICANT), owners of 198 Oneida Ln., Malvern, have applied for Zoning Variances. The applicant is requesting dimensional relief from the storage shed requirements outlined in the zoning ordinance, specifically §240-32 P.(b). The applicant proposes to install a second storage shed on the property, located within the rear yard area. Additionally the proposed shed is 15 feet tall and does not meet the 12 foot height requirement for sheds.

Pursuant to Township policy, property owners within 1000 feet of the subject property are notified of Zoning Variance applications.
