When you dial 9-1-1, from a phone associated with your Safety Profile that information automatically displays to the 9-1-1 call taker allowing them to send responders based on up-to-date location and emergency information. With your Safety Profile, responders can arrive aware of many details they would not otherwise know. Fire crews can arrive knowing exactly how many people live in your home and where the bedrooms are located. EMS personnel can know family members' allergies or specific medical conditions. And police can access a photo of a missing family member in seconds rather than minutes or hours, helping the search start faster.

15 Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance

16 David called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Marty led the Pledge of Allegiance. David called 17 for a moment of silence to recognize troops that are in harm's way, the police, emergency

- personnel and health care workers. David announced that the meeting is being livestreamed on
- 19 YouTube.

21 Chairman's Report

David announced that the Board met in executive session prior to the meeting to discuss real estate matters and personnel matters.

25 Fire Company Reports

26 Carmen reported the following fire company statistics for January in East Goshen:

- Goshen Fire Company responded to 15 fire calls, 8 fire police calls and 163 EMS calls.
- Malvern Fire Company responded to 21 calls 3 BLS (Basic) and 19 ALS (Advanced). He noted that there is a discrepancy by 1 on this report.
- Good Fellowship responded to 48 calls which is 10.8% of their total calls for the month.

32 Fire Marshal Report

33 Carmen explained that he met with the new administration at Thorncroft about enacting an

- 34 Emergency Plan.
- 35

36 Mike questioned if there is a need for Good Fellowship to separate and distinguish miscellaneous

- call types between ALS and BLS. Carmen said that the different levels of service may need to bebroken out for the county. Carmen will verify with Good Fellowship.
- 39

40 Westtown East Goshen Police Report

- 41 Chief Bernot focused her report on one issue: "How will the Police Department communicate
- 42 with residents if there is an emergency?" She emphasized that there are only 3 ways for
- 43 communication:
- 44 1. Reverse 911 Officers will notify a 911 dispatcher who in turn will send out an update. This,
- 45 however, is only beneficial for homes with land lines.

- Crimewatch Emergency Notification System Both an email and text are sent to subscribers.
 Residents must actively <u>sign up for this service.</u>
- Ready Chesco This notification is only for large scale emergencies. Residents must actively
 sign up for this service.
- 5 Chief Bernot stated that less than ½ of the total residents have signed up for Crimewatch. She
- 6 stressed the importance for the public to do so.
- 7
- 8 David stated that the next newsletter will emphasize and encourage residents to sign up for
- 9 Crimewatch.
- 10

11 Financial Report

- 12 Rick reported that as of January 31, the general fund had a deficit of \$574,325 which is not
- 13 unusual for this time of the year. He continued that on the expense side all departments were
- 14 under budget. Revenues from the earned income tax, real estate transfer tax and the code
- 15 department were all strong. The in-house audit has been complete. The auditor is completing the
- 16 work on their end.
- 17

18 Approval of Minutes

- Michele made a motion to approve the minutes of January 26, 2021, and February 2, 2021. John
 seconded. The motion passed 5-0.
- 21

22 Approval of Treasurer's Reports

- 23 Michele asked Rick if there has been any success recouping fees with the Brandywine SPCA
- 24 ordinance. Rick stated he was unaware of any fees being recovered but will verify. John made a
- 25 motion to accept the receipts and approve the expenditures as presented in the Expenditure
- 26 Register and as summarized in the February 11, 2021, Treasurer's Report. Mike seconded. The
- 27 motion passed 5-0.

30 **Recommendation for Milling Machine Bid**

- 31 Michele made a motion to accept the bid from CC&T /Groff Tractor in the total amount of
- \$35,000 for (two weeks) for two machines or \$17,500 for (one week) for two machines. Mike
 seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.
- 34

35 Recommendation for Dimensional Variance for 198 Oneida Lane

- 36 Carl Holden, 198 Oneida Lane, explained that he is requesting a variance from Section 240-32-P
- 37 of the Zoning Ordinance regarding storage sheds and accessory buildings. He wants to construct
- a storage shed with 182 square feet with a maximum height of 15 feet. He stated that he wants to
- 39 keep the same aesthetics of the existing house.
- 40 Michele made a motion that the Board of Supervisors support the dimensional variance request
- 41 to permit the proposed 182 square foot storage with a height of 15 feet maximum as depicted in
- 42 the application, for the following reasons:
- 43 1. The dimensional variance relief sought by the applicant will have no adverse effect on the
- 44 essential character of the neighborhood.

- The relief sought is the minimal relief needed to construct the new storage shed so that it will
 match the architectural style of the existing dwelling.
- 3 John seconded. The motion passed 4-1 with Mike opposed.
- 4
 5 Stormwater agreement for 632 Thorncroft Drive
 - Mike made a motion to authorize the Chairman to sign the stormwater management, operation
 and maintenance agreement for 632 Thorncroft Drive. Michele seconded. The motion passed
 5-0.
- 8 9

10 Change the Sewer Rate Billing Period

- 11 Rick explained that Aqua provides the 1st quarter water consumption data that is needed to
- 12 calculate and set the sewer rates for the Board's approval. This information is usually sent by
- 13 Aqua to the Township by approximately April 5. The new rates need to be reflected in the April
- 14 15th bills that are sent to all residents on public sewer. There is not adequate time allowed for
- 15 verifying the water consumption data against the usage data. It is being suggested that the Board
- 16 defer setting the rates until the first meeting in May, and, in turn the rates will become effective
- 17 the 3rd Quarter Billing cycle. This would reduce revenue for 2021 by about \$34,000. In 2022 the
- 18 revenues would match the expenditures. The sewer fund balance is more than adequate to cover
- 19 this shortfall. Michele made a motion to schedule a public hearing for an ordinance to
- 20 permanently make the new sewer rates effective with the July (3rd Quarter) billing cycle. John
- 21 seconded. Mike asked if this \$34,000 was a permanent loss or would it be recouped to which
- 22 Rick replied permanent. Rick said he could check with Chris Boylan to discuss how to
- implement without the loss. John made a motion to table this motion. Michele seconded. The
- 24 motion to table was passed 5-0.
- 25

26 Resolution 2021-191 to Authorize Disposal of Township Records

- David made a motion to adopt Resolution 2021-191 on Disposal of Township Records. Michele
 seconded. The motion passed 5-0.
- 29

30 Resolution 2021-58 to Authorize Execution of PennDOT Mowing Agreement

- 31 Michele made a motion to adopt Resolution 2021-58 that authorizes the Chair to execute the 32 moving agreement with PennDOT. Mike seconded. The motion passed 5-0.

34 Any Other Matter

- 35 Michele made a motion to appoint Jessica Bottaro to a full member from an alternate member of
- 36 the Park and Recreation Commission. Marty seconded. There is now one alternate member
- 37 vacancy on the Park and Recreation Commission. The motion passed 5-0.

The General Fund revenues include \$60K from Verizon 4Q2020 Cable Franchise.

The Capital Reserve account includes \$222K in grant funds received, which is offset by expenditures paid out for the Paoli Pike Trail. Additionally, the final payment of \$89K was received from the State for PPT Segment F-G.

The Bond Fund incurred \$351K in expenses for the West Goshen Sewer Treatment Plant improvements per the agreement in place with West Goshen.

# Memo East Goshen Township

As I noted in my memo of February 11, 2021, the Board sets the sewer new rates at the first meeting in April, which this year will occur on April 6th and the new rates are effective with the second quarter bill which must be mailed by April 15th.

However, we will not receive the consumption data from Aqua for the first quarter until the week of April 5th which does not give us time to check the consumption data against what was used in the previous billing cycle.

I would suggest that the Board defer setting the rates until the first meeting in June, and have them take effect with the third quarter billing, July 15, 2021.

This would reduce our revenue for 2021 by about \$34,000.

The Board asked if this change can be accomplished without reducing our revenue in 2021.

We have 6,627 units on public sewer, each of whom pay the fixed rate. To recoup the \$34,000 over the next two billing cycles in 2021 we would need to add in an additional \$2.57 when we calculate the fixed rate. (34,000/6,627 = 5.13 then 5.13/2 = \$2.57)

Attached is the draft ordinance.

**Suggested motion** – I move that we schedule a public hearing for an ordinance to make the new sewer rates effective to with the July (3rd Quarter) billing cycle,

## ORDINANCE NO. 2021-____

#### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE EAST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP CODE, CHAPTER 188 TITLED "SEWERS" SECTION 188-4 TITLED "VARIABLE RATES" TO AMEND THE TIME FRAME FOR AMENDING THE VARIABLE RATES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of East Goshen Township that Chapter 188 of the East Goshen Township Code, titled, "Sewers" shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 188-4 titled "Variable rates" shall be amended as follows:

A. §188-4.A(2) shall be revised to state as follows:

"To determine the average water usage per quarter, the Township shall calculate the average quantity of water used during the fourth quarter of one year and the first quarter of the succeeding year (referred to as the "fourth quarter-first quarter cycle"), as evidenced by meter readings from water meters installed by the company which provides public water or such other meters or measuring devices as may be installed pursuant to the provisions of this article. The average water usage value shall be updated annually for the July billing cycle."

B. §188-4.B(2) shall be revised to state as follows:

"To determine the average water usage per quarter, the Township shall calculate the average quantity of water used by each multifamily dwelling unit, based on either individual water meter readings or averaged in accordance with Subsection <u>**B(3)**</u> below, during the fourth quarter-first quarter cycle as evidenced by meter readings from water meters installed by the company which provides public water or such other meters or measuring devices as may be installed pursuant to the provisions of this article. The average water usage value shall be updated annually for the July billing cycle."

<u>SECTION 2. Severability</u>. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts hereof. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

**<u>SECTION 3. Repealer</u>**. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

**<u>SECTION 4.</u>** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective five days from the date of adoption.

Recycling in East Goshen-Proposal to BOS

We recommend that the Township undertake a pilot program to provide approximately 110, 50 or 65 gallon lidded toters at no cost to residents on a first come, first served basis to gauge interest. The cost would be approximately \$7000 and would come out of the Refuse Fund.

Background:

A review of recycling in East Goshen (single family residences that fall under Township collection) indicates little improvement in recycling over the last 10 years. We feel that part of the problem may be the type of recycle bins the Township provides free of charge. They are small, about 20gal, and do not have a lid. Many households have more than one bin. We believe that in order to send a message to residents to recycle more the Township needs to encourage the use of lidded wheeled toters.

Goals of this Program:

- 1 Gauge resident interest in larger, lidded bins.
- 2 Encourage residents to recycle more
- 3 Reduce litter (lids prevent blowing of recycled items, paper, cardboard, etc.)
- 4 Reduce recycle ending up landfilled because it is wet.
- 5 Reduce the cost of landfilling
- 6 Ultimately, allow curbside recycling of plastic bags and film

The SAC plans to provide recycling information along with the bins. We will also ask the new bin users to respond to a simple survey after 3 months to gage overall effectiveness.

Last fall the Board requested that I look into the feasibility of creating an emergency access from the cul-de-sac on Linden Lane to Goshen Parkway.

The access would need to cross a vacant lot that is owned by Synthes. I reached out to Synthes and they would be willing to grant us a temporary easement for the emergency access.

Attached is the temporary easement agreement that was been prepared by our solicitor and reviewed by Synthes.

Suggested Motion: I move that we authorize the Chair to execute the Temporary Emergency Access Agreement with Medical Device Business Services, Inc. which is a successor in interest to Synthes USA HQ, Inc.

#### **TEMPORARY EMERGENCY ACCESS EASEMENT AGREEMENT**

THIS TEMPORARY EMERGENCY ACCESS EASEMENT AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is made this _____ day of ______ 2021 by and between **MEDICAL DEVICE BUSINESS SERVICES, INC.,** an Indiana corporation, successor in interest to **SYNTHES USA HQ, INC.,** a Delaware corporation with an address of 1302 Wrights Lane East, West Chester, Pennsylvania 19380 ("Grantor") and **EAST GOSHEN TOWNSHIP**, a political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania with an address of 1580 Paoli Pike, West Chester, Pennsylvania 19380 (the "Township").

#### **RECITALS:**

WHEREAS, Grantor owns a parcel of real property containing a total of approximately 4.9 acres, more or less, located at 1311 Goshen Parkway, West Chester, Pennsylvania 19380, such real property being identified as UPI No. 53-3-1.16 (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Property is located on the southwest side of Linden Lane, which is a public cul-de-sac street with numerous dwellings located thereon; and

WHEREAS, a stream known as Chester Creek crosses underneath Linden Lane via two 41" X 71" culverts; and

WHEREAS, during extreme rain events, the portion of Chester Creek that crosses underneath Linden Lane floods, overtopping a section of Linden Lane and blocking vehicular ingress and egress to and from the cul-de-sac; and

WHEREAS, certain dwellings on Linden Lane have only one means of ingress and egress to and from such dwellings, such ingress and egress being blocked by floodwater during extreme rain events; and

WHEREAS, the Township intends to construct a hard surface emergency access road approximately 10 feet wide with a widened area that would allow two vehicles to sufficiently wide to allow two vehicles to pass (the "Road") on a portion of the Property to benefit the residents of Linden Lane and to be used by such residents and emergency vehicles as a secondary means of ingress and egress in the event of an emergency; and WHEREAS, the parties desire to establish and memorialize a non-exclusive emergency access easement over a portion of the Property, subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties, each intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

1. <u>Incorporation of Recitals.</u> The background paragraphs set forth in the Recitals above are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth at length herein.

2. **Grant of Temporary Easement.** Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, as well as the advantages to it accruing as for diverse and other considerations affecting the public welfare which it seeks to advance, has granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Township and its successors and assigns a non-exclusive emergency access easement over and across the Property in the approximate location depicted on the map attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference (the "Temporary Easement"), such Temporary Easement including the right of the Township to construct the Road.

#### 3. Use of Easement.

A. The Township and the public shall be entitled to use the Temporary Easement and the Road as an emergency access road which shall provide a secondary means of vehicular and pedestrian ingress and egress for residents of Linden Lane and emergency vehicles only in the event of an emergency when Linden Lane is impassable to vehicular traffic.

B. Grantor shall not erect, maintain or allow any improvements on, over and under the Temporary Easement, or take or allow any action which would affect free and unimpeded access to or use of the Road and other rights and privileges granted herein. Grantor shall prohibit barriers, structures, fences, curbs or other obstructions from impeding the free and unhampered use of the Temporary Easement and Road. Notwithstanding the above restriction, Grantor and its successors and assigns in title to the Property shall be permitted to use the Temporary Easement and Road in any manner not inconsistent with the use of such Temporary Easement and Road as an emergency access road.

#### 4. Construction of Road within the Easement.

A. The Township shall construct the Road within the Temporary Easement leading from Goshen Parkway to the east and terminating on Linden Lane. The Township, through its employees, agents, contractors and subcontractors shall be solely responsible for constructing the Road within the Temporary Easement. The Township and its employees, agents, contractors and subcontractors shall construct the Road in accordance with sound engineering and construction principles and shall perform any work within the Temporary Easement in a good and workmanlike manner so as to create the least interference with the Property. The Township shall notify Grantor at least seven (7) days prior to commencing construction of the Road on the Property.

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B. If requested by the Grantor, the Township shall install a gate at the entrance to the Road at or near the boundary line between the Property and Linden Lane and a gate where the Road accesses Goshen Parkway. The gates shall remain closed at all times except in the event of an emergency when the Road must be used as a means of emergency access for the residents of the dwellings on Linden Lane.

C. The Township, promptly following or exercising its rights and privileges hereunder to construct the Road within the Temporary Easement, shall backfill any areas excavated, compact the ground as may be appropriate and fully restore the surface of the ground to substantially its condition prior to such disturbance (except for the cartway of the Road). Any areas outside of the cartway of the Road which were disturbed during the construction shall be filled, compacted and seeded with grass as may be necessary to restore the surface of the Property to substantially its condition prior to such disturbance.

D. The Township shall not permit any claim, lien or other encumbrance arising from the construction of the Road on the Property to accrue against or attach to the Property. If any such claim or lien is filed against the Property as a result of work performed or materials provided for the construction of the Road, the Township shall satisfy said claim as promptly as possible.

5. <u>Maintenance of Road.</u> The Township shall be responsible for all costs of installation and maintenance of the Road. "Maintenance" shall include, repairing and filling potholes; removing debris and any and all obstructions which may impair clear passage along the Road, tree trimming and removal within the Temporary Easement, and maintaining any gates that may be installed.

6. Term. The parties hereto agree that the term of the Temporary Easement shall commence at such time as Township commences construction of the Road. The term of the Temporary Easement shall continue until (i) Grantor or its successors or assigns obtains final subdivision or land development approval from the Township to develop any portion of the Property in a manner where the Temporary Easement interferes with the proposed development of the Property, or (ii) Grantor or its successors or assigns enters into an agreement for the sale of the Property, whichever is earlier (the "Terminating Events"). If either of the Terminating Events occurs, the Temporary Easement shall terminate immediately and the parties shall execute a Release of Temporary Emergency Access Easement Agreement which shall be recorded by Grantee, at its sole cost and expense, and returned to Grantor, provided, however, that in the event of a Terminating Event, Grantor and its successors or assigns agree to negotiate in good faith with the Township to memorialize a permanent emergency access easement over and across the Property in a different location provided that such alternative location does not impede Grantor or its successors and assigns in title to the Property from developing the Property in the manner they deem appropriate. Grantor and its successors and assigns shall have no obligation to grant a new emergency access easement over the Property in the event of a Terminating Event; however if the parties are able to negotiate and agree upon an alternative location for a new emergency access easement on the Property, the parties shall memorialize such agreement in writing and such new agreement shall replace and supersede this Agreement.

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#### 7. Indemnity and Insurance.

A. The Township agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless Grantor from and against any damage, liability, claim, settlement, cost and expense, award, judgment, damage, fine, fee, or other loss suffered by Grantor arising out of (1) any injury and/or loss and/or damage caused by the acts or omissions, or intentional misconduct of the Township or its agents, employees, contractors, subcontractors, assigns or successors-in-interest, in the construction and maintenance of the Road and its performance of its responsibilities hereunder; or (2) any personal injury or death or property damage resulting from the use of the Road after the date of this Agreement, including, without limitation, any use by the public or by the Township or any of its agents, employees, licensees, contractors, subcontractors and invitees; provided however, that such injury or damage was not caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of Grantor and provided that this indemnification shall not extend or apply to Grantor or its successors or assigns' use of the Road as a driveway or means of access to the Property. ģ

B. The Township shall obtain and maintain during the entire term of this Agreement adequate public liability and property damage insurance policies covering any injury, death or property damage resulting in any way from the use of the Temporary Easement and Road on the Property. Such insurance policies shall provide bodily injury, including death, and property damage coverage in the minimum amount of One Million (\$1,000,000.00) Dollars per occurrence and Two Million (\$2,000,000.00) Dollars in the aggregate. The insurance policies shall be occurrence based and shall name Grantor as an additional insured. The insurance policies shall provide that such policy may not be cancelled without first giving Grantor thirty (30) days' prior written notice of cancellation.

8. <u>**Running with the Land.</u>** This Agreement and the Temporary Easement created herein shall run with the land and bind the Property and the Grantor's successors and assigns in title to the Property.</u>

9. <u>Notices.</u> Any notice or other communication given hereunder or pursuant hereto shall be in writing and shall be personally delivered (in which event such notice shall be deemed effective only upon such delivery), or sent by a nationally-recognized overnight delivery service (which provides a receipt of delivery), or delivered by mail, sent by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, to such party at the address set forth below:

All notices shall be deemed given when received. A party may change its address by giving notice of such change in the manner herein provided. In the event the Property or any portion of the Property is conveyed, all notices shall be to the new owner's address on file with the Chester County Assessment Office. Unless and until such written notice is received, the last address and addressee stated by written notice, or as provided herein if no written notice of change has been sent or received, shall be deemed to continue in effect for all purposes hereunder.

10. <u>Modifications.</u> This Agreement may be amended, modified or terminated only by a written addendum signed by the then owners of the Property and the Township.

11. <u>Governing Law.</u> This Agreement shall be interpreted and enforced in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

12. <u>Binding Agreement.</u> This Agreement shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, successors and assigns.

13. <u>**Recording.**</u> This Agreement shall be recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Chester County, Pennsylvania by Township.



WHEREAS, when calling 811 at least three business days before digging a homeowner or contractor is connected to this unique service that notifies the appropriate underground utility operators in the municipality in which the work will be performed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the East Goshen Township Board of Supervisors recognize the month of April, 2021 as "Pennsylvania 811 Safe Digging Month" and the Board of Supervisors encourage all homeowners to dial 811 at least three business days in advance of any excavation project, including even small projects such as planting a tree or installing a mailbox post.

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

### What do we do?

We are the "Call before you dig!" company for all of Pennsylvania. If you plan to disturb the earth with powered equipment, you are required by Pennsylvania law to notify the underground utility companies of your intent to do so. Notification occurs by calling 8-1-1 or 1-800-242-1776, 24 hours of the day, every day of the year. Notification can also be done on our website at www.paonecall.org.

We will then notify the utility companies nearby of your intent to dig. The utility companies are responsible to mark where their underground lines are located with colored flags, paint or chalk.

**Please Note:** 

- PA One Call does not mark utility lines.
- In some cases, the utility company may not mark the service lines you own.
- If you need your sewer drain cleared be sure to check www.paonecall.org/crossbore for Call Before You Clear information or call 811 for more information.

## Why should you call?

Safe digging is no accident! If you are installing a fence or deck, or digging for a mailbox post, patio or other excavation project, it is important to Know What's Below. Dial 8-1-1 or 1-800-242-1776 before you dig. The utility companies do not want an accident, either. The best way to learn where underground utility lines are located is to call before you dig.

### Homeowner Quick Tips

- One easy phone call to 8-1-1 three to ten business days before digging begins helps keep your neighborhood safe.
- Call on Monday or Tuesday if you plan to dig on Saturday or Sunday.
- The utility companies will mark where their underground lines are located with colored paint, flags or chalk.
- Do not remove the flags if you see them in your yard.
- Our service is no cost to homeowners.
- Did you hire someone to install your fence, deck or new patio? Ask to see the PA One Call serial number before allowing them to dig on your property.

I think we could get more than that if we sell it outright.


