### 14 Adelphia Status

Derek reported that he spoke to a representative at Adelphia and emailed the TF prior to the meeting. The key points were discussed:

- The East Goshen location is not used for planned maintenance. It is too far south.
- The valve will be checked every six months (2 times a year) as required by law. It will not be vented.
  - If venting is necessary, Adelphia will inform local 911, the Township and surrounding residents. A muffler would also be installed when venting to suppress the noise.
  - There is no product running through the pipeline. It is planned to start running natural gas in Quarter 1 of 2022.

- How far away and at what depth is Sunoco placing the anode from the pipeline.
- Has the soil type been considered?

- 5. Contribute to the East Goshen Township quarterly newsletter with information in easy-to-understand formats for the public.
- 6. Attend the monthly Chester County Sunshine meetings.
- 7. Revisit East Goshen Noise and Public Nuisance ordinances.
- 8. Fill vacancies on task force to achieve full staff of seven (7).
- 9. Explore a specific pipeline emergency evacuation plan for the Township. Provide input to development of this plan as appropriate.
