Call to Order

Chairman's Report

1. Sandy was thinking of Mark Miller and his family. She sent a card from the Conservancy Board.

3. She led a discussion of the need to repair the Township's two LED signs. She will send a letter to the BOS from the CB asking that they be repaired.

Old Business

1. Keep East Goshen Beautiful Day - This will be held on Saturday April 23, 2022. Walter will send out a notice on March 23rd and Sandy will send Susan an email to put on the website.

New Business

1. Weeds, Inc. - Mark commented about the Weeds invoice and Broan's proposal for 2022. Mark spoke with him about Supplee Valley. Brian provided a separate invoice for Reservoir Road/Supplee Valley for \$450.00. Walter made a motion to approve Weeds Inc. to do the Supplee Valley area not to exceed \$500.00. Erich seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

2. Bee Hives Placement in Supplee Valley Open Space – Sandy reviewed Jason's memo regarding the Supplee Valley Open Space. This 26.1 acre township open space is off Reservoir Road near E. Strasburg Road. It is passive park space with a creek and grass path. There is parking for 4-5 cars, but most of the usage is from the connected neighborhoods.

Dan feels there is a benefit to this but if there is a problem with a neighbor, Carmen has to understand he may have to remove the hives.

3. Newsletter Article– Sandy will add this item to the agenda. It needs to be submitted by next week. Mark made some suggestions. Sandy will write the article.

4. Arbor Day – This is the same day as the KEGBD so it was decided to plant a tree in Clymers Woods later that day. Eunice suggested a Black Gum tree.
