- <u>D. Visited Ashbridge Preserve</u> on Monday 4/4/22 with Andrew Kirkpatrick (Stewardship) and Lauren McGrath (Watershed), both of WCT. We walked the preserve back to the restoration site along Ridley Creek. Topics covered included:
 - 1. The "Habitat At Home" project...folder packet/native species
- 2. WCT partnering with Edgemont Township, e.g. newsletter items and <u>Streams Learning Day</u>. Edgemont has partnered with Willistown Conservation Trust and the CRC Watersheds Assoc. to present a Streams Learning Day! The event will take place on June 11, 2022 from 9:30 to 11:30 am at Ridley Creek State Park. This is a chance to learn about water quality, the surrounding natural habitat and why streams are so important to our environment.
- 3. Noted availability of partnering with respect to MS4 permit compliance/grants, e.g., storm water retention basin, tree planting that enhances MS4 compliance.
- 4. Stream bank restoration Planting native trees including fruit trees to hold old pond bed soil in place, attract area residents who might be interested in native species and native fruits; received approval from Lenni Lenape on the project.
- 5. Water quality testing including EnviroDIY real time sensors, two of which are monitoring the Ridley Creek in Ashbridge (Lauren noted a significant temperature variation between the shaded sensor and the unshaded sensor).
- 6. We discussed what an East Goshen creek-side resident outreach program might
- Dan mentioned that Ridley Creek goes through the township on a lot of private land. The homeowners need to be educated.
