Call to order, Pledge of Allegiance and Moment of Silence

July minutes were approved

Business:

Tom reviewed potential Paoli Pike Trail(PPT)/neighborhood connector options. These options will need some additional vetting before presenting to the BOS. Tom will followup with Mark Miller to get his input. Dave provided hard copies of the trail connector options presented in the PPT master plan.

The options presented were:

- 1 Connect to Colonial Dr and the Cornwallis neighborhood along 352 with a new path across the front of the Bible Church property and a short stretch thru the Dentist office parking lot. This path would be about 150 yards and open up trail access to approximately 70 homes. Consider paving options other than asphalt.
- 2 Connect Bow Tree development along wide shoulder on 352 from north end of Bow Tree Drive to the path just south of the Blacksmith Shop. Put up barrier along this section to protect pedestrians/bikers from auto traffic. The shoulder is about 8 feet wide and is currently striped. Also consider a path connecting the parking lot at the back of the Blacksmith Shop with the parking lot to the wooden observation deck parking lot. There is a trail from here through the open space by Applebrook preserve that connects in to the PPT. This connection would provide access to about 500 residents. 3 Marydell/New Kent connector along 352 from Barker drive as laid out in the PPT Master Plan. This connector would provide safe access for about 670 homes.

4 Connect Bittersweet/Grand Oak thru existing right of way off Linden Lane at rear of CDI in the Business Park to the Trail thru the Business park which has bike lane marked. This would connect over 189 homes with about 100-150 yards of trail.
