Members in 7 attendance are indicated in BOLD: 8 Sandra Snyder, Chairman 9 Dan Flynn, Vice Chairman 10 **Erich Mever** 11 **Scott Sanders** 12 13 Walter Wujcik Karen Martynick 14 15 Others present were: 16 Michele Truitt, Township Supervisor 17 Ashley Nowak, Office Administrator 18 Eunice Alexander, Goshen Tree Tenders 19 20 21 Call to Order Sandra called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. 22 23 Pledge of Allegiance & Moment of Silence 24 Sandra led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance and then asked for a moment of silence 25 to remember our first responders, military and medical. 26 27 28 **Minutes** The minutes of the January 11, 2023 meeting were approved as amended. 29 30 New Business Subdivision/Land Development Review 31 Applebrook Turf Maintenance - Brett H. MacKay, Senior Associate at Chester Valley 32 Engineers represented the applicant. The Board members have been provided with a 33 Landscape/Site Plan. The Applebrook Golf Club wants to update their maintenance facility 34 located at Hibberd Rd. and Paoli Pk. They are proposing to enhance the berm along Paoli 35 Pike and extend the privacy fence. He confirmed that no trees will be removed. Sandra 36 looked up the species they want to use and none are invasive. She spoke about the proper 37 way to mulch the trees. Brett explained that currently they just wash the equipment off. 38 The plan includes a wash island with a drain that will take the excess water into the building 39 where it will be treated and sent to the sanitary sewer. There is an onsite storm water 40 management system. Dan is very concerned about the Ridley Creek. He read from the State 41 of Streams report for this area. Sandy mentioned permit requirements. The golf course has 42 been there a long time, and this may be a better collection system. Erich referred to the 43 plans presented to the Planning Commission. Brett commented that filters will be installed 44 and maintained to trap debris. The Landscape Plan was reviewed. Walter made a motion to 45 accept the Applebrook Turf Maintenance Landscape Plan. Dan seconded the motion. The 46 motion passed unanimously. Sandy will send a letter to the Planning Commission. 47 48 49 50

- 2 <u>1. New Member</u> Sandra welcomed new member Karen Martynick. Karen mentioned that
- 3 she is currently retired. She was on the Conservancy Board when it first started. She was a
- 4 Chester County Commissioner for a few years. A large part of her work has been with
- 5 conservation trusts that saved about 40,000 acres of land from development.
- 2. Annual Planning Meeting Sandra reported that she made the presentation and
 feels everything went well.
- 8 3. Surveys The Futurist Committee did a survey in 2022 and everyone feels the
- 9 return was very good. It was about open space and planting trees.
- 10 4. Environmental Sustainability Committee (ESAC) Sandra mentioned that ESAC
- has a goal for this year to plant shrubs around the Township sign in front of the
- 12 Township building. Sandra feels someone on the CB should participate.
- 13 <u>5. Newsletter</u> The due date for articles for the Township newsletter have been
- changed. Also a paper newsletter will be mailed. Ashley confirmed that the
- 15 newsletter schedule is April, August and December/January. The deadline for the
- April edition is February 17. Sandra will submit an article about mowing, fertilizing
- 17 and mulching trees for Spring.
