Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance

Chairperson's Report

Gerry shared that the PTF's current top two priorities are 1) PHMSA proposed rulemaking on gas pipeline leak detection and repair, and 2) carbon dioxide pipelines.

PHMSA-2021-0039 Pipeline Safety: Gas Pipeline Leak Detection and Repair

Gerry sent a draft letter (with previous comments from members) to review at this meeting. The group discussed several additional edits. Gerry will update the letter and send the final version to the group for approval by Monday August 14, 2023. Old Business

Leak detection at valve stations

No update.

ME2 Pipeline Construction Records

Ashley shared that Derek sent the subject letter to PHMSA. Gerry shared that originally we spoke with State Representative Pielli about sending a letter of support. However, since PHMSA is a federal agency Derek suggested reaching out to U.S. Representative Chrissy Houlahan. Ashley will follow up with Derek and ask him to update the group.

PA One Call System (811) Improvements

Ashley shared that Derek has started working with Rep. Pielli's office on this matter. He will update as needed.

Carbon dioxide pipelines

David had previously shared the information summary provided by Gerry with the BOS. At the BOS meeting on 07/18/2023, Supervisor Michelle Truitt asked Judi to draft an ordinance regarding carbon dioxide pipelines. Judi will email a copy of this draft to the group.

A new area of concern is the repurposing of existing hydrocarbon pipelines for CO₂ service. This would be accomplished by installing a liner inside the carbon steel pipe. John believes it may be a spray application rather than inserting a sleeve. The PTF needs a better understanding of this topic. Gerry asked Paul and John to research the lining of existing pipelines and share their findings with the group. Judi stated she will reach out to Ginny Kerslake to see if she has any additional information.

New Business

Proposed work by Adelphia Gateway in or near Bow Tree Development

The scope of this proposed work was uncertain. Ashley will ask Derek to email the group with an update. There was also a question if this is a natural gas transmission or distribution line.
