Goshen Tree Tenders** 20 Peg Friese, Goshen Tree Tenders 21 Christi Marshall, Chairman of ESAC 22 23 Call to Order 24 Dan called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. 25 26 Pledge of Allegiance & Moment of Silence 27 Dan led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance and then asked for a moment of silence to 28 remember our first responders. 29 30 31 The minutes of the May 8, 2024 and June 12, 2024 meetings were approved. 32 33 **Chairman's Report** 34 None 35 36 **Subdivision/Land Development Review** 1. 14 Reservoir Road - Property owner Jeff Closson and Yerkes engineer, Michael Bartsiera 37 38 were present to review the plans for a flag lot house. Jeff explained that he started this 39 process several years ago. Because of nearby flood plans, it took 2 years to get a planning 40 module from the DEP. He commented that no trees will be removed. He provided a photo 41 of the south side of the lot which shows his neighbor's tree line. They have selected White 42 Spruce to plant. Walter warned about using only one variety. Eunice spoke about wind 43 sheer. She suggested some flowering trees to go with the White Spruce. Stormwater 44 collection will be underground. Walter moved to let Dan write a letter to the Planning 45 Commission about their review of this plan and suggestion to use only native plants. Karen 46 seconded the motion.
