NEW BUSINESS

1. America250 Event - In 2026 America will be celebrating its 250th year! Jason is planning to have a joint event with West Goshen. In 1776 this area was known as Goshenville. This event will replace Community Day but be very similar to it. The event concept would mirror the EGT-WGT Bicentennial Celebration held in 2016. Some event components could include:

- Brief dignitary parade into EGT Park
- Historical Reenactors
- Play
- 1776 depictions of how Americans lived then
- Kid activities
- Food Trucks
- Fireworks (this could be a combination of fireworks and drones)

Anticipated event budget is between \$30,000 and \$36,000. Cost would be shared with WGT.

Next Steps: EGT & WGT would agree to an event date, budget, and begin discussing the event program.

Jessica made a motion to recommend partnering with West Goshen Township to host an America250 event in EGT park in 2026. Ann Marie seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

- 1 2. Review - The Yard Sale was good. Parking at the township building is always crowded.
2 The Art Walk was held at East High School because of the weather. We used the main gym (50 Artists) and the
3 Auxiliary gym (30 Artists). There was one food truck. Attendance was very good. They liked the Treasure Hunt
4 game and artists donated some of their art for prizes for this game. Jason acknowledged the young men from West
5 Chester University who provided help getting the artists set up. Comments were that signs were needed to show
6 the way to the Auxiliary Gym and they liked it indoors because it was easier to walk around and see all the art
7 work.

9 3. Friends of East Goshen - Jason commented that FOEG presented a check for \$32,000 to the Park & Recreation
10 Commission. FOEG has a remaining balance of \$10,000. It has been a good year of fund raising.

12 4. Pumpkin Festival & Food Truck & Music Festival - These events will be held on Saturday, October 12, 2024.
13 The Pumpkin Festival will be from 10:00 am to 12:00 noon. There will be two food trucks with breakfast food.
14 The Girl Scouts will have hot chocolate. The Bach to Rock band will provide music.
15 The Food Truck & Music Festival will be held the same day from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm also in the EGT park. Food
16 trucks will be available and two bands.

18 5. Ping Pong Parkinsons - This is a national nonprofit organization. They meet on Tuesday at the EGT Building
19 from 9:30 am to 11:00 am. There are 3 – 6 people attending and it is helping them.

21 6. The Malvern Library was refurbished and will reopen on November 16 at 2:00 pm.

23 7. Veterans Day - On Monday November 11, 2024 at 10:00 am there will be a ceremony at EGT park.
