Approved Bulk Trash Items:

- Box springs
- Chairs
- Desks (metal or wood)
- Dishwashers
- Grills (Gas grills must have propane tank removed. Propane must be taken to a propane distributor.)
- Lawn mowers: Gas tank must first be removed & oil must be drained. Riding mowers NOT accepted.
- Mattresses
- Metal filing cabinets
- Microwaves: Smaller microwave units can go out with regular trash.
- Printers
- Rugs/Carpet: Must be cut into 4' rolled lengths and tied or taped
- Snow blowers (with gas and oil drained out)
- Sofas
- Stoves/Ovens
- Washers/Dryers
- Water heaters (must be empty!)
- Windows (EXCLUDING large bay-type windows. Glass must be taped for removal.)
- Wooden furniture

Approved Appliances WITHOUT Freon:

- Microwaves: Smaller microwave units can go out with regular trash.
- Stoves/Ovens
- Washers/Dryers
- Water heaters (MUST BE EMPTY)

Approved Appliances with FREON REMOVED

In order for these items to be accepted, the Freon must be removed by a certified technician. The technician will have to put an approval sticker on the item. Click <u>here</u> to view a listing, provided by the Chester County Solid Waste Authority, of Freon recovery service companies.

- Air conditioners
- Freezers
- Humidifiers/Dehumidifiers
- Refrigerators

* FREON RECOVERY INFORMATION *

The Clean Air Act of 1990 requires recapture, recycling, and safe disposal of chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) and hydro chlorofluorocarbons (HCFCs) used in air conditioners, refrigerators, and freezers as coolant. Under the Act, no one may accept an item containing CFCs and HCFCs for recycling or disposal unless the Freon contained within it is properly removed and the owner/hauler/appliance company can show proof of proper removal. It is also unlawful for any person to knowingly release or vent CFCs or HCFCs into the air. The EPA requires certification for all technicians removing Freon as of 11/14/94. - Roofing shingles
- Swing sets
- Tile
- Window decking
- Wood & metal fencing

NON-APPROVED: ALL HAZARDOUS MATERIALS AND CHEMICALS:

- Batteries
- Tires
- TVs

Items marked with any of the following words are HAZARDOUS:

- Caution
- Corrosive
- Combustible
- Danger
- Explosive
- Flammable
- Hazardous
- Poisonous
- Reactive
- Toxic
- Warning

Use the <u>HHW Collection Events</u> to dispose of unwanted Hazardous Household Waste as identified in the above list.
