**NEW BUSINESS**

**1. Reorganization** - Since the current officers agreed to stay in office, Debbie made a nomination to continue Eric Tobin as Chairman, Peter Knapp as Vice Chairman and Karen Battavio as Secretary. Kishor seconded the nomination. The nomination passed unanimously.

**2. 2025 Programming and Events Calendar** - Jason reviewed the 2025 Programs and Events Calendar. The only changes made were for Camp Registration which will start on February 6<sup>th</sup> for residents and February 13<sup>th</sup> for non-residents. Also the date for the Tree Lighting was changed to December 1<sup>st</sup> a Monday night at 6:30 pm. The Commission members approved the calendar.

**3. Events for Seniors** – Debbie mentioned that she is planning a Wacky Winter Olympics for Seniors. It will be held on January 23, 2025 at 1 pm at the Township Building. She described the 6 events planned so far. She needs judges. Other events will be February 13<sup>th</sup> Valentines event, March St. Patrick’s Jeopardy, and Christmas in July. She commented that the Book Club has about 17 members and she expressed thanks to the Malvern Library.

1 4. Reindeer - Greet Snow the Reindeer went very well. There were about 55 families. Jason feels that next year  
2 we should change the fee back to \$50. The professional photographer took photos that were put on the website.  
3 One photo per family was free but they could purchase additional photos if they wanted.

5 5. New Logo Design – Jason mentioned that the current Logo was designed in 2013 and we’ve added a full time  
6 staff member, numerous park facilities , many programs and the logo no longer encompasses all that EGTPR means  
7 to our community. He outlined his plan to include the community in selecting a new logo and plans to put it in the  
8 2025 winter Newsletter.

10 6. Food Trucks – Jason provided a list of the food trucks and what they provide. He also indicated what events they

21 lights. He will contact the 4 residents near this field if needed. He will review this plan with the BOS at their next  
22 meeting. The Township Engineer will make a quote of costs for engineering, electric, water, etc. The commission  
23 members were very impressed with this project.
