Goshen Tree Tenders 23 Nada Neskovic, West Chester East Environmental Club 24 Russ Frank, East Goshen Resident 25 Christie McCormack, Hershey's Mill Nature Committee 26 27 Call to Order 28 Dan called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. 29 30 Pledge of Allegiance & Moment of Silence 31 Dan led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance and then asked for a moment of silence to 32 remember our first responders, police, fire fighters and EMTs. 33 34 **Minutes** 35 The minutes of the May 14, 2025 meeting were approved as amended. 36 37 Subdivision/Land Development Review 38 1344 Morstein Road - Adam Brower of Edward B. Walsh Assocs. was present. Dan 39 commented that the BOS asked that the CB review these plans and get back to them with 40 their thoughts. Adam explained that the property is a 5 acre lot which the owner wants to 41 subdivide. The new lot will be 1.34 acres. Currently there is a 16' driveway from the main 42 street (Morstein Rd) past two other properties to the current house. They will have to make 43 the driveway into a private road at 20' wide to accommodate emergency vehicles. The 44 property is considered a wooded lot and can't remove more than 20% of the trees. Some 45 trees will have to be removed in order to widen the driveway. The plan shows that about 46 40 trees will be removed measuring 5 to 14" wide. They reviewed the landscape plan which 47 listed the types of trees. Adam will check that they are native and on the Township list. 48 The new lot is on a slight slope. Dan asked about drainage on the private road. Adam 49 commented that they will do Stormwater Management. He explained the size and amount 50 of storage the SW Basin will have and that it will flow off quickly. The homeowners will be 51 responsible for having the annual inspection done. Adam mentioned that he does SWM

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inspections for West Whiteland Township and explained the process. Julie commented that the inspection should include the trees along the private road. Adam mentioned that the homeowners will form an HOA to maintain the properties. Dan will send a letter to the BOS.

1. Mr. Russ Frank spoke to why the CB meetings are not on UTube, some other meetings are. Dan replied that that would have to come from the BOS.

- <u>1. Applebrook tree maintenance</u> is ongoing. Julie mentioned that she spoke with a CRC member who was weeding the trees. He commented a few trees did not survive.
- 2. Weeds Inc. They have been spraying for invasives for many years. The areas they cover
   are along Reservoir Road and the wetlands at the Blacksmith Shop. The CB members will
   visit these areas on Thursday June 19th at 8:30 am and meet at the Reservoir Rd. area.
- 3. Conservancy Board and ESAC overlap was discussed. Mr. Frank asked where the CB mission statement is. Karen commented that it is on the website and they will tell him where.
- 4. KEGBD 25 Walter mentioned that he provided a list of everyone who participated this
   year.
- 5. Water Quality Dan reached out to Willistown. Their report should be out in August.
   Derek gave a good presentation last month and gave information for County services so Dan will make that call.
  - <u>6. Meadows</u> The CB needs to look for areas that can become meadows. There are grants available for the Township to get. Mr. Frank commented that the Marydell Pond area is all overgrown and needs to be looked at.
