Dear Residents:

The East Goshen Township Public Works Department will soon begin preparing the streets in Waterview Farms for paving. The milling and paving will take place in August. The actual milling (preparation of the road surface) is scheduled to begin the week of Monday, August 4, 2025, and we expect that the entire process, from milling to the completion of paving, will take approximately two weeks, weather permitting. During those two weeks, our crew will be working Mondays through Thursdays, beginning at approximately 7:00am through approximately 4:00pm.

Important points to remember during the paving process:

- We will post your street the day before we begin paving.
- Please <u>do not park on the street</u> beginning Monday, 8/4/25, through the completion of the paving. Any car parked on the street will be towed away if our crew needs to start work and we cannot locate the owner to get it moved.
- We will maintain traffic flow during the milling and paving work so you will be able to get in and out; however, expect delays.
- You must put your trash, recycling, and yard waste out the NIGHT BEFORE your regularly-scheduled pickups. We will have the hauler swing through first thing on pickup mornings, before we start paving.
- As soon as the asphalt has been rolled (i.e., the paving is done), you will be able to
 drive on it. The only thing we ask is that you do not turn your wheels sharply for 24
 hours following the completion of paving.
