Attached please find the Treasurer's Report for the weeks of August 28, 2025- October 2, 2025.

EIT collections, Transfer Tax revenue, real estate tax collections, state aid & volunteer fire association funds received, quarterly recharges, interest income, insurance claims, rent, permits, alarm fees, and P&R registration fees drove General Fund revenue during this period.

General Fund expenses include the monthly WEGO contribution, vehicle maintenance/repairs, highway materials and equipment rental, P&R programs and events, insurance payments, pension contributions, disbursement of volunteer fire state aid received, and routine operational expenses.

Expenditures from the Capital Reserve Fund include \$21K for chipper payments (rent to own).

The ARPA Fund incurred \$4K for catering of the ABC Appreciation event.

\$11K of Infrastructure Sustainability Fund expenses include pond treatments, water sampling, the final seeding of Bow Tree I, and Open Space tree removal.

Re: Real Estate Tax Collection Renewal with County

Members of the Board of Supervisors, we have been contacted by the Chester County Treasurer's Office inquiring whether we will renew our contract for the collection of East Goshen Real Estate Taxes. This is a one-year renewal and there is no price increase. The County will evaluate the cost for 2027 and 2028 next year. As we do not currently have the available software in-house and there is no cost increase, I recommend the Board allow the Township Manager and myself to extend the contract by renewal for 2026 via email. There is no document to sign. This renewal will allow the Finance Team the time necessary to perform a cost analysis of whether bringing real estate tax collection back in-house is more effective than utilizing County services by reviewing software options, personnel/training, and postage/equipment costs. Sometime in 2026 we will also get new 2-year (2027-2028) contract renewal pricing to assist in the analysis.

We would request a voice-vote to proceed authorizing the Township Manager and/or Finance Manager of East Goshen Township to renew Chester County Real Estate Tax Collection services for 2026.

OPERATIONAL OVERVIEW

- The Goshen Fire Company is celebrating its 75th year of service to the community
- We are a volunteer-run organization with 25 responding volunteer firefighters, 5
 active EMS staff and 15 active Fire Police Officers.
- We have 12 full-time firefighter/EMT's and 14 active part-time employees
- In 2024 we ran 692 fire calls and 5001 EMS calls
- We provide Fire, EMS and Fire Police Services to 35,000 residents in four townships:
 - 98% of East Goshen Township
- 60% of Westtown Township
- 40% of West Goshen Township
- 16% of Willistown Township

FY 2026 Overview

The Goshen Fire Company has prepared an income and expense forecast for Fiscal Year 2026. This forecast is based on year-to-date performance for FY 2025, and includes two important staffing initiatives.

- In order to provide better coverage and reduce overtime costs, we are adding four (4) full-time firefighter/EMT's to cover shifts that, in the past, we have tried to fill by part-time employees. We currently have 14 active part-time employees to fill the hours of 10.3 full-time equivalents.
- 2. We are hiring a full-time EMS leader. This new position replaces our volunteer EMS chief who, after serving for many years, is stepping down at the end of 2025. We have an extremely flat organization, especially for an EMS agency running over 5,000 calls per year.

FY 2026 Overview

Other Notable Budget Items:

- EMS Billing and EMS Subscriptions represent 47% of our income (\$1,920,049)
- Fundraising and Donations represent 9% of our income (\$380,741)
- Requested Township contributions represent 39% of our income (\$1,586,528)
- 2026 Operating Expenses include new Full-Time firefighter/EMT positions and the hiring of a leader for our EMS program.
- We are reducing our Apparatus Replacement Reserve funding from \$276,000 per year
 to \$132,000 per year

Municipal Contribution Request

Fleet Strategy

The Fire Company has been taking a hard look at our long-term fleet strategy to manage operating expenses without impacting service levels. We have:

- Retired and sold Rescue 54, transferring the rescue equipment to two (2) pumpers
- Removed Ladder 56 from the replacement schedule, which means we are no longer dedicating funds for its replacement in the future
- Plans to remount two (2) existing ambulances onto new chassis, saving approximately \$150K per ambulance.

As a result, our Apparatus Capital Reserve annual funding has been reduced by \$144,000 (from \$276K to \$132K), and these savings have significantly reduced our current and future township funding requests.

Other significant fleet-related cost controls:

- · We limit the number of non-frontline vehicles (utility vehicles) in our fleet.
- Our Relief Association (2% foreign fire tax funds) pays 25% of the cost of all fire apparatus.

Overview:

Parks and public spaces have always been a community's best place for people of differing viewpoints to come together through shared experiences. This can easily be seen on playgrounds, where kids of different backgrounds learn to play and share communally owned spaces together. For adults, it's very much the same. People who may have different political viewpoints can find common ground and shared interests among sports, programs and activities like bocce, basketball, pickleball and many more. East Goshen Parks and Recreation very much believes that it delivers programs and activities for all residents to the best of its abilities and appreciates its role as the place for common ground and shared experiences.
