4 roads, the township has to cut back on the salt. Milkweed may be a plant that will absorb  
5 salt. Need to do research for a solution. Jackie suggested Stroud Water Research. Sandy  
6 also suggested looking at what the more northern states and perhaps Canada are doing. Do  
7 they have a salt problem? Karen mentioned that Milkweed does take up salt but can impact  
8 insects. Karen commented that this is a good project for the CB and ESAC to work on  
9 together. Julie and Ken will work on this.

11 **4. Fall Planting** - The CB budget was discussed. Ashley will check on the budget amount  
12 and see if Weeds Inc has been paid. Whatever funds are available Mark Miller will be asked  
13 to plant trees. Meadows were discussed. It was decided to write an article about meadows
