17 Gerry called the meeting to order at 10:04 am.

4 **Chairperson's Report**

5 Gerry summarized an article on the piloting of a methane pyrolysis process that produces
6 so-called "turquoise" hydrogen. Pyrolysis is a high temperature reaction without oxygen.
7 Methane pyrolysis does not produce carbon dioxide gas. Rather, the byproduct is carbon
8 in solid form which is easier to transport and has many industrial applications. This
9 process uses five times less electricity than electrolytic hydrogen production and does
10 not require water. There are significant environmental advantages to this technology.

12 Gerry also summarized an article titled "Consequence Analysis of the Satartia Carbon
13 Dioxide Release."

15 **Old Business**

16 **Discuss draft letter to PennDOT appealing their decision on Paoli Pike guide railing
17 at Williams/Transco natural gas valve station**

18 Judi had some comments to improve the clarity of the wording. Gerry will incorporate
19 these. All edits need to be sent to Gerry by 01/23/2026 so he can send the final version to
20 Derek for the next BOS meeting. Ashley reported that Derek reached out to the
21 Williams/Transco, but he has not heard back. [PMN: The BOS approved sending this
22 letter at their meeting on 02/03/2026.]

25 The topic for this article is our 2025 accomplishments. Gerry presented a first draft for
