**Discussion with CRC -** Julie introduced Danni Scott of CRC and commented that CRC donated and planted the trees in Applebrook Park. Danni is the Restoration Specialist. The tree planting was done prior to her. They have a Tree Care Team that will visit the sites and make notes if there is anything to be done. The only thing they can't do is water the trees, but they prune and weed them. She asked about Supplee Valley. A discussion followed. Peg suggested shrubs with berries in Applebrook for the birds. She spoke about a pond in the Applebrook area that is suffering erosion.

3 1. Clymer's Woods - The poster is falling apart. Julie designed a new poster.

13 1. KEGB Day - Although Keep East Goshen Beautiful Day was cancelled due to bad weather,

17 2. PECO Arbor Day - This event was held on April 24, 2026. But the proclamation was not  
18 done. It was decided to meet on Saturday, May 16<sup>th</sup> at 10 am at the Township Building and  
19 then go the Clymers Woods. Ann Duffield volunteered to read the proclamation. The trees  
20 from PECO were a mixed variety and will be planted in Applebrook and Supplee Valley.

24 There has to be a proclamation from the Board of Supervisors. Julie will provide the  
25 proclamation. Julieta mentioned that Willistown has a report every week that documents  
26 what kind and how many birds were seen.
