Old Business:

Possible passage of Resolution 2026-04, Intergovernmental Agreement 1338 Morstein Road/Schiffer Tract Residential Subdivision.

Anne made a motion to adopt Resolution Number 2026-04 to authorize entering the intermunicipal Services Agreement with West Whiteland Township to provide services to the three new lots located within East Goshen Township.

Larry seconded.

Motion carried 5-0.

Discussion and possible authorization to advertisement ordinance for special sewer district, 1338 Morstein Road/Schiffer Tract Residential Subdivision.

Larry made a motion to authorize the Township Manager and Township Solicitor to advertise proposed Ordinance No. 1 29-A-2026 to establish a special sewer district known as the Zernatt Station Road Subdivision Sewer District.

Barbara seconded.

Motion carried 5-0.

Parks and Recreation Red, White, and Blue Sports initiative.

Jason gave a review of the program.

Anne recommended the Parks and Recreation Department implement the Red, White and Blue Sports program in the 2026 calendar year.

Bid results for 2026 Milling Machine Contract

ESAC Composting Survey
