**Call to Order**

Julie called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**Pledge of Allegiance & Moment of Silence**

Julie led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance and then asked for a moment of silence to remember our First Responders and others who keep us safe.

**Approval of Minutes**

The minutes of the April 8, 2026 meeting were approved.

**Discussion with CRC -** Julie introduced Danni Scott of CRC and commented that CRC donated and planted the trees in Applebrook Park. Danni is the Restoration Specialist. The tree planting was done prior to her. They have a Tree Care Team that will visit the sites and make notes if there is anything to be done. The only thing they can't do is water the trees, but they prune and weed them. She asked about Supplee Valley. A discussion followed. Peg suggested shrubs with berries in Applebrook for the birds. She spoke about a pond in the Applebrook area that is suffering erosion.

**Chairman's Report -**

Julie thanked Nada Neskovic, West Chester East Environmental Club for her help. Emily was with her and will be in charge next year.

### **New Business -**

1. Clymer's Woods – The poster is falling apart. Julie designed a new poster.
2. Survey – There was discussion of sending a survey out to the residents about seminars and workshops. After discussion it was decided to send the survey to the residents.
3. Newsletter – Articles for the fall Newsletter are due by June 30<sup>th</sup>. Julie has started an article about Clymer's Woods.

### **Old Business**

1. KEGB Day - Although Keep East Goshen Beautiful Day was cancelled due to bad weather, some people did do some cleanup.
2. PECO Arbor Day – This event was held on April 24, 2026. But the proclamation was not done. It was decided to meet on Saturday, May 16<sup>th</sup> at 10 am at the Township Building and then go the Clymers Woods. Ann Duffield volunteered to read the proclamation. The trees from PECO were a mixed variety and will be planted in Applebrook and Supplee Valley.
3. Bird Town PA update - We have a draft application. Julie has been working on this. There has to be a proclamation from the Board of Supervisors. Julie will provide the proclamation. Julieta mentioned that Willistown has a report every week that documents what kind and how many birds were seen.
4. America250 East Goshen vs West Goshen Bioblitz - There is a committee for this event. Dates for EG vs WG are Saturday September 12 or Sunday September 20 at 10 am. Dorothy Verdon of WG is a communication expert who will handle organizing for this.
