



# Solicitation Information for Residents

To help residents stay informed, we're sharing important information from the Township's Peddling & Solicitation Ordinance (Ordinance No. 169).

## Solicitation Without a Permit is Prohibited

Individuals must obtain a valid Township-issued permit before:

- Selling or soliciting the sale of food, goods, services, or printed materials
- Soliciting donations or pledges
- Going door-to-door or operating on public streets and highways within East Goshen Township

## Religious or Non-Commercial Canvassing

Groups engaging in religious or non-commercial outreach are not required to obtain a solicitation permit, provided they are not selling goods or services or requesting donations.

## Ordinance Highlights

- **Permit Required** – Solicitors must obtain a Township-issued permit before conducting business.
- **Photo ID Badge** – Approved solicitors are issued a Township photo ID badge that must be worn and visible at all times.
- **No Uninvited Entry** – Solicitors may not enter or attempt to enter a residence without the owner's invitation or permission.
- **Permitted Solicitation Hours:**
  - Monday–Friday: 9:00 AM – 8:00 PM
  - Saturday: 9:00 AM – 6:00 PM
  - Sunday: 12:00 PM – 6:00 PM
- **Do Not Call/Knock List** – Residents may opt out of solicitation by submitting a Do Not Call Registration Form to be added to the Township's Do Not Call/Knock List.
