Chris asked each member to introduce 30 31 themselves to Bill and tell a little about them. Then Bill told the group that he has always had an interest in history. He collects post cards and stamps and has written many articles. 32 33 34 ACTIVITY CALENDAR Kathryn commented that Community Day on Sat. June 22, 2013 was added to the calendar. 35 36 37 TREASURER'S REPORT Monica had no updates to give. 38 39 **CHAIRMAN'S REPORT** 40 41 Chris reported that he received a call from a Cub Scout leader, but hasn't spoken to her yet. 42 Chris met with Mark Miller and Christopher Cummings and his father on Monday. The sign will be located by the fence at the Plank House on the garden side facing the boardwalk.
