Others present: Kathryn Yahraes, and Ben Rohrbeck.

Call to Order

Judy called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance & Moment of Silence

Judy led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance and asked for a moment of silence for our troops.

Minutes

The Chairman noted that the minutes of January 9, 2014 were approved as corrected.

Treasurer's Report

Dolores volunteered to take this position since Monica is on the Planning Commission now. Judy met with Jon Altshul, Township CFO. He commented that the Township cannot take donations except through the Friends of East Goshen. The bank account that was set up for the Plank House when it was erected has a \$1,600.00 balance. The HC must use this money so the account can be closed. However, Dolores pointed out that this money can only be used for the Plank House. Ben suggested completing the museum that was going to be put on the second floor of the Plank House. Judy mentioned that Sandy Snyder, Chairman of the Friends of East Goshen, will be attending the HC's March meeting to explain how donations can be made.

Chairman's Report

- 1. Judy reminded everyone that next Tuesday, Feb. 25 at 7:00 pm there will be the hearing for removal of 1331 E. Strasburg Rd from the Historic Resource Inventory.
- 2. Judy mentioned that Montejean Gay will have her interview with the BOS next Tuesday, Feb. 25 to become a member of the HC.

Old Business

- 1. Comprehensive Plan Update Chris explained that the format of the updated Comp Plan will be very different from the original, which was very complex. Chris gave everyone a copy of Chapter 5 from the original CP, which covers sec. 240 of the Township Ordinance. It covers historic preservation, inventory criteria for classification, permitted uses, etc. The responsibility of the HC when a Historic Resource owner wants to remove it from the Township list, is to hold a hearing, ask questions and make a decision. Discussion of Chapter 5:
- Page 1 Objective 5B Add after Hershey's Mill "and other historic areas as identified".

 Action 5A-1-5 Remove entire item.

Chris will meet with John Theilacker, Project Manager, Brandywine Conservancy, to discuss these changes. Kathryn pointed out that the new Landscapes II can be added as a reference.

- 2. 2014 Goals & Objectives Judy wants to be sure the Historic Resource Inventory is complete and as accurate as possible. Ed commented that the first step is for the Commission to take a tour of the township to check the properties.
- 3. Open Space Plan Chris just received the draft. Historic viewscapes will be included. Other items covered by the plan are privately owned open space, infill, and a trail along Paoli Pike.
- 4. Battle of the Clouds Chris confirmed that Sean will make this presentation on Thursday, May 22. The large meeting room has been reserved. The cost will be \$250.00. Chris made a motion to approve \$250 for Sean to make this presentation. Dolores seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. There was discussion about the need for people to make a reservation to attend because of the limited capacity of the room.
- 5. Calendar of Events Judy would like to have this calendar posted each quarter on the Township website. Chris spoke with Jason Lang, Director of Recreation, who agreed to help Chris with social media. Ben asked when the BSS will be open this summer. Judy commented that dates will be set at the March meeting.

Kathryn mentioned that the Dark Valley Questers meeting is scheduled for March 14.

Ben commented that the Brandywine Battlefield Re-enactment on May 17 & 18, is not being held at the Brandywine Battlefield. It is being held at the park at the end of South New Street, West Chester. The members of the Commission decided that they will not participate in this event.

Bill is going for the training this weekend to be a judge for the National History Day event. The event will be held at the Chester Co. Historical Society Building this year.

Kathryn reminded everyone that "Keep East Goshen Beautiful Day" is Saturday April 5th.

The celebration in 2017 – Senya will be chairman of the committee that will oversee this event.

6. Volunteer Form – Judy asked Sue and Kathryn to get together and review this form and bring it to the March meeting for the Commission members to review.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Zoning Hearing Board of West Goshen Township will conduct a public hearing on **Thursday, March 13, 2014 at 7:00 P.M.** at the Township Administration Building, 1025 Paoli Pike, West Chester, PA 19380. The hearing will be held in the public meeting room on the second floor of the building, at which time the following Zoning Hearing Board Application will be heard:

ZHB 2-14: The applicant and legal owner is Sunoco Logistics Partners, 525 Fritztown Road, Sinking Spring, PA 19608. The property for which the application is made consists of a 4.42 acre lot located at 1261 Boot Road; being Tax Parcel No. 52-1-10.1, and is zoned R-3 Residential. The Applicant seeks special exception approval pursuant to Section 84-12.E (3) to permit a public utility facility use on the Property. The proposed public utility facility use includes a pump enclosure, piping, valves, and a vapor combustion system. The vapor combustion system is proposed to be 34 feet in height. The maximum building height requirement is 30 feet, the applicant is therefore seeking additional special exception approval pursuant to Section 84-48.B to permit the vapor combustion system to be a height of 34 feet. In addition, the applicant seeks any additional relief that may be required to allow the applicant to construct a pump station, including a fenced in stone pad, enclosures for power distribution, the pump equipment, and a 34 ft. high vapor combustion system.
