Eagle Scout Project – A proposed project is to replace the fence at the Plank House. The cost is estimated to be \$1,600. Rick Smith wants the Historical Commission to use the 503c1 funds at the 37 Susquehanna Bank. However, these funds are to be used to acquire items for use in the Plank House. 38 There is a possibility that they can purchase a spinning wheel so the Plank House would have a "hands 39 on" activity. Judy did send an email to Jon Altshul stating this but hasn't received a response. Dolores 40 feels the Township should pay for the fence same as they paid for the new roof on the Plank House. 41 42 Judy asked Ellen to make a list of items the HC wants to get for the Plank House. 43

Ellen feels that by working with other organizations and sites, we can get items we want and may be able to trade some of the things we won't use. Dolores has a preliminary list of items the HC wants to acquire. Judy will meet with Jon Altshul.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

- 1. Research Ed reported on the Sullivan House at Hershey's Mill, the Rees family and Ely Rees. He had a copy of the History page from the Hershey's Mill website. He pointed out a few things that were incorrect. He is doing 2 small projects for Karen Marshall.
- 2. Bill reported that this past weekend he had 2 competitive displays at the Phila. National Stamp Exhibition at Oaks. One display was about carte'de vistes with tax stamps which were a type of business card used during the Civil War. There were 17 photographers in the West Chester area during this time. There were no income taxes but everything else was taxed. His collection of carte'de vistes covers 30 years of collecting. The other display was about train trips across PA.
- 3. Historic Resources List 1331 Strasburg Road. The commission held a hearing for the request to remove this location from the Historic Resources List. The commission decided unanimously to retain this location on the HRL since it had some historic value and the buyer was not going to demolish it. The HC was very disappointed that the BOS decided to remove the location from the HRL.
